- 2. What are conductive, sensorineural and mixed hearing statuses?
- 3.I would like to see an audiogram and learn more about what it means.
- 4. I would like to see something that explains my child's hearing levels in a way I can understand.
- 5. I would like a demonstration or simulation of my child's hearing levels.
- 6. If I choose hearing technology for my child, what device(s) would you recommend and why?
- 7. Will my child's hearing levels change over time or is it permanent?
- 8. Would you recommend genetic testing to see if something could have caused a difference in my child's hearing levels that would also impact their health?
- 9. Could you refer me to a speech-language pathologist with experience in working with deaf or hard of hearing infants and toddlers?
- 10. Could you put me in touch with the schools for the deaf/hard of hearing in Luquillo and/or San Juan? If you cannot, can you refer me to other professionals with experience educating deaf/hard of hearing children?
